General Rules- Please Read:

1. Exhibitors must be under 23 years of age as of April 15.
2. Any Exhibitor who violates any of the following rules will forfeit all premiums and privileges.
3. All out of state swine must have interstate transport permits to be eligible in The Moonlight Classic.
4. All exhibits will be under the control of the show management. The Moonlight Classic, Spring Youth Fair or Southwest Washington Fair is NOT RESPONSIBLE for any loss or damage that may occur.
5. All animals brought for exhibition are at the owner's risk. The show management will not be held responsible for injuries occurred by animals or injuries or damages inflicted on a third party by said animals and in no event will be held liable for the death of an animal.
6. The Moonlight Classic show management has the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences arising from these rules and regulations.
7. All exhibitors consent to being photographed during The Moonlight Classic.
8. Abusive language, un-sportsmanlike conduct abuse of an animal or a blatant disregard for others and their property, during the show may have the following consequences: Expulsion from current show and up to and through the next year, loss of premiums and rewards, and removal of ALL exhibits. The decision will be at the discretion of the show management.
9. All exhibitors must be in primary control of their animal during weigh-in, showing and fitting. Animals exhibiting extreme wild or dangerous behavior will be isolated or removed from the Fairgrounds.
10. Animals must be fed appropriately and watered throughout the entire show. Noncompliance may result in expulsion.
11. Exhibitors must provide their own Bedding, feed, feeding and watering equipment.

12. All market prospect classes will be divided by weight.
13. The superintendent has the authority to change, combine or cancel classes to fit the livestock entries.
14. Removing or remedying physical defects of conformation in exhibition animals, such as lifting or filling under the skin, will be considered as fraud and deception. All animals giving evidence of such treatment will be barred from exhibition.
15. All animals are subject to inspection by the onsite vet technician. If animal shows evidence of any infectious or contagious disease or any insightful condition (such as warts, ringworm, fungus, etc.) it will not be allowed into the show. A veterinarian may be brought on site for a final determination of disease at owner's expense. Animal will be asked to be removed immediately from show. All out of state animals must have their transportation permit.
16. We support and encourage the humane treatment of all animals. Animals showing any evidence of mechanical repair will not be allowed. Exhibitors are expected to treat their animals with respect and provide for their continuous well-being through proper feeding, handling, disease prevention, sanitation and attention to their safety.
17. Exhibitors must keep pens in show condition to qualify for premiums and awards.
18. No Garbage in the waste bedding; pop cans, twine, etc.
19. The prospect classes will be divided by weight.
20. Dogs are only permitted in the designated camping area.
21. All checks will be mailed to the address on the entry form.
22. There will be no refunds on entry fees.
23. All returned checks will be charged an additional \$30.
